Screening tests

Female screening tests (P10: female screen) <i>Chlamydia, Gonorrhoea, FBC, Hep B sAg, Hep B core, Hep C, HIV, Rubella</i>	£150
Male screening tests (P11: male screen) <i>Chlamydia, Gonorrhoea, Hep B sAg, Hep B core, Hep C, HIV</i>	£100

All patients intending to undergo treatment need to undergo screening tests within 3 months of their first treatment cycle and 1 year of subsequent cycles for both the male and female partner. Female patients must also have had a cervical smear within the last 3 years.
