All patients intending to undergo treatment need to undergo screening tests within 3 months of their first treatment cycle and 1 year of subsequent cycles for both the male and female partner. Female patients must also have had a cervical smear within the last 3 years.

Payment and cancellation terms for treatment charges

- A deposit of £2,500 is due when you consent to accept a particular donor (per the donor acceptance consent form) in order to reserve that donor
- You have a 14 day cooling off period (from the date of signing the donor acceptance consent form) during which you may change your mind and obtain a full refund of your deposit
- Should you change your mind after the 14 day cooling off period your deposit will not be refunded
- You waive the right to the above cooling off period if you accept the donor within 14 days of the intended date of starting stimulation for the donor
- The full treatment charge must be paid before the intended date of starting stimulation for the donor
- If you do not receive at least the minimum guaranteed number of eggs, your treatment charge will be refunded in full and you will be charged for the monitoring scans and blood tests that you have had per our current prices
- Similarly, if your donor withdraws from treatment, your treatment charge will be refunded in full and you will be charged for the monitoring scans and blood tests you have had per our current prices
- Should you decide to withdraw from treatment after the donor has commenced stimulation, there will be a £5000 treatment cancellation charge (including the deposit)

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
